

DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER FOR PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY

Extended -30 days

WHEREAS, beginning in December 2019, a novel coronavirus, now designated as COVID-19, was detected in mainland China, and has since spread throughout the world; and

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization declared COVID-19 a worldwide pandemic on March 11, 2020; and

WHEREAS, President Trump signed a Proclamation declaring a National Emergency Concerning the Novel Coronavirus Disease (COVID-10) outbreak on March 13, 2020,

WHEREAS, Texas Governor Abbott declared State of Disaster in Texas due to COVID-19 on March 13, 2020,

WHEREAS, extraordinary measures must be taken to contain COVID-19 and prevent its spread throughout Sabine County, Texas; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS:

- 1. That a state of disaster is declared for Sabine County, Texas, pursuant to section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
- 2. That the County's Emergency Management Plan has been implemented.
- 3. That this state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days of the date hereof, unless the same is continued by consent of the Commissioners' Court of the County of Sabine, Texas
- 4. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
