#### Driving Directions

From the Sabine County Courthouse in Hemphill, go one block east on Farm Road 83  
(Worth Street), then right on State Hwy 87 South for 9.6 miles, then left on Farm  
Road 2928 for 4.2 miles to end of pavement, then continue on Lakeview Road  
for 2.7 miles, then left on Oakhill Road for 0.4 miles to the park.  
(Lake View Recreation Area)
