APRIL 25, 2022 - 9:00 AM**


The Commissioner's Court of Jones County, Texas, met this day in regular session with the following members present: Dale Spurgin, County Judge, presiding; Roy Spalding, Commissioner Precinct 1; Lonnie Vivian, Commissioner Precinct 2; and Joel Spraberry, Commissioner Precinct 4.

- 1. APPROVE MINUTES OF THE LAST REGULAR MEETING.**
Commissioner Vivian entered a motion to approve the minutes from the April 11, 2022 regular meeting as presented. Commissioner Spalding seconded the motion with Commissioner Spraberry voting aye.
- 2. DISCUSS PRECINCT 3 COMMISSIONER VACANCY AND PROCESS TO FILL VACANCY.**
No action was taken by the Commissioners Court.
- 3. DISCUSS AND TAKE ACTION ON DISASTER DECLARATION FOR DR-4416 AND ALL ITEMS RELATED REGARDING FEMA AND TDEM FORMS AND REQUIREMENTS.**

19. **DISCUSS AND TAKE ACTION TO CLOSE CR 263 0.6 MILE BETWEEN FM 704 AND HWY 6.** No action was taken by the Commissioners Court.

Commissioner Spalding seconded the motion with Commissioner Spraberry voting aye. See Exhibit H.
24. **DISCUSS AND TAKE ACTION ON TREASURER'S REPORT.** Commissioner Spalding entered a motion to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Commissioner Vivian seconded the motion with Commissioner Spraberry voting aye. See Exhibit I.
25. **AMEND BUDGET AND APPROVE LINE ITEM TRANSFERS.** Commissioner Spalding entered a motion to amend the budget and approve line item transfers as presented. Commissioner Vivian seconded the motion with Commissioner Spraberry voting aye. See Exhibit J.
26. **PAY BILLS.** Commissioner Spalding entered a motion to pay the bills as presented by the Auditor. Commissioner Vivian seconded the motion with Commissioner Spraberry voting aye.


Commissioner Spraberry entered a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Spalding seconded the motion with Commissioner Vivian voting aye.




 County Judge




 Commissioner Precinct 2




 Commissioner Precinct 4
