

**JONES COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT
REGULAR MEETING
JANUARY 22, 2024 - 9:00 AM**

The Commissioner's Court of Jones County, Texas, met this day in regular session with the following members present: Dale Spurgin, County Judge, presiding; Lonnie Vivian, Commissioner Precinct 2; Ross Davis, Commissioner Precinct 3; Joel Spraberry, Commissioner Precinct 4; and LeeAnn Jennings, Jones County Clerk. Roy Spalding, Commissioner Precinct 1 was absent.

- 1. APPROVE MINUTES OF THE LAST REGULAR MEETING.**
Commissioner Vivian entered a motion to approve the minutes from the January 8, 2024 regular meeting as presented. Commissioner Davis seconded the motion with Commissioner Spraberry and Judge Spurgin voting aye.






The Extension Office submitted an office agenda for the Court to review. See Exhibit I.

Commissioner Spraberry entered a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Davis seconded the motion with Commissioner Vivian and Judge Spurgin voting aye.



County Judge
