

**JONES COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT
REGULAR MEETING
MAY 12, 2025 - 9:00 AM**

The Commissioner's Court of Jones County, Texas, met this day in regular session with the following members present: Dale Spurgin, County Judge, presiding; Roy Spalding, Commissioner Precinct 1; Lonnie Vivian, Commissioner Precinct 2; Danny Collett, Commissioner Precinct 3; Joel Spraberry, Commissioner Precinct 4; and LeeAnn Jennings, Jones County Clerk.

- 1. APPROVE MINUTES OF THE LAST REGULAR AND CALLED MEETINGS.**
Commissioner Spalding entered a motion to approve the minutes from the April 28, 2025 regular meeting as well as the April 29, 2025 called meeting as presented. Commissioner Vivian seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye.
- 2. DISCUSS AND TAKE ACTION ON A BID SUBMITTED BY CODY ROBERTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF R17526, WEBB & HILL LUEDERS BLOCK 24, LOTS 12-13, THE BID AMOUNT IS \$1200.00. 21. PAY BILLS.


Commissioner Vivian entered a motion to pay the bills as presented by the Auditor. Commissioner Spalding seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye.


ADJOURN

Commissioner Vivian entered a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Spalding seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye.



County Judge
