- 1. APPROVE MINUTES OF THE LAST REGULAR MEETING.
 - Commissioner Spalding entered a motion to approve the minutes from the February 24, 2025 regular meeting as presented. Commissioner Vivian seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye.
