

**JONES COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT
REGULAR MEETING
MARCH 10, 2025 - 9:00 AM**

The Commissioner's Court of Jones County, Texas, met this day in regular session with the following members present: Dale Spurgin, County Judge, presiding; Roy Spalding, Commissioner Precinct 1; Lonnie Vivian, Commissioner Precinct 2; Danny Collett, Commissioner Precinct 3; Joel Spraberry, Commissioner Precinct 4; and LeeAnn Jennings, Jones County Clerk.

1. APPROVE MINUTES OF THE LAST REGULAR MEETING.

Commissioner Spalding entered a motion to approve the minutes from the February 24, 2025 regular meeting as presented. Commissioner Vivian seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye.

2. DISCUSS AND TAKE ACTION ON A BID SUBMITTED BY KAREM ALSHENDI FOR THE PURCHASE OF (R29045), LOT 3, IN BLOCK 51, OF THE ORIGINAL TOWN OF ANSON, JONES COUNTY, TEXAS. THE BID AMOUNT IS \$1300.00. COURT COST HAS BEEN WAIVED. Commissioner Spraberry entered a motion to approve a bid in the amount of \$1300.00 submitted by Karem Alshendi for the purchase of R29045. Commissioner Spalding seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye. See Exhibit A.

13. DISCUSS AND TAKE ACTION ON ADVERTISEMENT FOR PROPOSALS FOR CARPET IN THE COURTHOUSE. Commissioner Spraberry entered a motion to advertise for proposals for carpet in the courthouse. Commissioner Spalding seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye. See Exhibit F.

14. DISCUSS AND TAKE ACTION ON POSTAGE MACHINE LEASE AGREEMENT WITH QUADIENT LEASING. Commissioner Vivian entered a motion to approve the postage machine lease agreement with Quadient Leasing for a postage machine located in the Tax Assessor Collectors Office. Commissioner Spalding seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye. See Exhibit G.

15. DISCUSS AND TAKE ACTION TO PURCHASE SHELVES FOR SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT. Commissioner Vivian entered a motion to approve the purchase of sixty shelves from Walmart in the amount of \$13,198.20 to be paid from permanent improvement. Commissioner Spalding seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye. See Exhibit H.

No action was taken by the Commissioners Court.


20. AMEND BUDGET AND APPROVE LINE-ITEM TRANSFERS.
