- 1. APPROVE MINUTES OF LAST REGULAR MEETING. Commissioner Spraberry entered a motion to approve the minutes from the July 27, 2020 regular meeting as presented. Commissioner Davis seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye.
- 2. DISCUSS AND TAKE ACTION ON DISASTER DECLARATION AND ALL ITEMS RELATED REGARDING FEMA, TDA AND TDEM FORMS AND REQUIREMENTS. No action was taken by the Commissioners Court.
