- 1. APPROVE MINUTES OF LAST REGULAR MEETING.
 - Commissioner Davis entered a motion to approve the minutes of the April 13, 2020 regular meeting as presented. Commissioner Spraberry seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye.
